

# **Gaston County Schools** Scholarship Report, Class of 2016

Our graduates in the Class of 2016 are ready for the future!

The comprehensive instructional program and many academic and extracurricular opportunities in Gaston County Schools prepare our graduates for college and careers.

We are extremely proud of the seniors in the Class of 2016 for their outstanding achievements in academics, athletics, fine arts, and extracurricular programs.

## At A Glance: The Numbers

- Total scholarship money offered to the Class of 2016: **\$53,058,200 million** 
  - This is a record amount for a graduating class.
- Number of scholarships offered to the Class of 2016: 1,392
- Number of scholarships offered to the Class of 2016 valued at \$100,000 or greater: 96
- Number of colleges/universities presenting scholarships to the Class of 2016: More than 170

## Scholarship Breakdown

More than **1,300** academic/merit scholarships (which includes military and fine arts) and **60** athletic scholarships were made available to the Class of 2016.

- Academic/Merit Scholarships: More than \$48.6 million
  - Military Scholarships: More than \$1.4 million
  - Fine Arts Scholarships: More than \$484,000
- Athletic Scholarships: More than \$4.4 million

TOTAL: More than \$53 million in scholarships offered to the Class of 2016

## **Scholarship Highlights**

■ Two seniors received a prestigious appointment to the United States Air Force Academy, which includes a scholarship that exceeds \$400,000 for each student.

■ Two seniors received scholarships through the QuestBridge program – one to attend Emory University in Atlanta and one to attend the University of Virginia. Each scholarship was valued at more than \$250,000.

■ Several seniors were among the Park Scholars at N.C. State University and the Levine Scholars at UNC-Charlotte. These awards provide a full-tuition scholarship along with many academic, extracurricular, and study abroad opportunities.
