B. Submit all required data TO CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP CHAIRMAN by deadline APPLICATIONS MUST BE IN THE HANDS OF THE CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP CHAIRMAN BY FEBRUARY 2. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE TIMELINE WILL ELIMINATE THE APPLICANT FROM CONSIDERATION.

C. Agree to report for interview(s), if requested

IV. SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT'S OBLIGATIONS

- A. Recipient can receive other scholarships for the time covered by this scholarship; however, should a full scholarship be received, the recipient must notify the State Scholarship Chairman and relinquish the scholarship.
- B. If the recipient withdraws from school during the freshman year, the recipient must notify the State Scholarship Chairman of this decision.
- C. In case the initial recipient withdraws during the first semester, the runner-up or first alternate, as applies to the situation, would become the recipient and would receive the second semester portion of the scholarship.
- D. The recipient should be a guest at the luncheon during the North Carolina Alpha Delta Kappa State Convention the year he or she is a freshman in college. The State Alpha Delta Kappa Scholarship Chairman will issue the invitation.
- E. Recipient will submit a written report/summary of his/her college experience during the year of the scholarship to the State Scholarship Chairman by April 20.

The **Clare Johnson Marley – Mary Earle Berger Fine Arts Scholarship** is open to any student who is currently graduating from an accredited high school in North Carolina, who expects to enroll in a four-year college or university next fall, and who is declaring as his/her major an area of the fine arts. This is a one-year (nonrenewable) scholarship in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2000).

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS

- A. Application submitted to college or university of choice
- B. Academic rank in top 20% of class
- C. Minimum SAT score of 1344 or ACT composite score of 20
- D. Good character
- E. Participation in extracurricular activities (school and community)
- F. Financial aid not the primary consideration
- G. Proof of abilities/talents in the area of fine arts by the submission of a CD/DVD or portfolio of work which demonstrates abilities/talents

PROOF OF TALENT MUST ACCOMPANY APPLICATION

- 1. MUSICAL TALENT:** It is suggested that the applicant choose for recording, compositions that are classical, romantic, impressionistic, or contemporary. The length may vary from four to ten minutes. Audio tapes will not be returned. Be sure to include, in writing, the titles and composers of the musical selection recorded.
- 2. DANCE:** A CD or DVD should be submitted demonstrating the talent. Be sure to include descriptive information on the dance. Length of the presentation may vary from four to ten minutes CD/ DVD can be returned, if requested.
- 3. VISUAL ARTS:** It is suggested that proof of talent in more than one medium be included. Four to ten examples of talent should be submitted. Portfolio will be returned, if requested.
Background information should include medium used, age when done, and any other information that might be of help to the committee.
- 4. DRAMA:** A CD or DVD should be submitted demonstrating talent. Other people may be in the dramatization, but the applicant's part should be primary. Either on the CD/ DVD or written form, an explanation of the "set up" and other pertinent information should be given. Script should be included. Length of presentation may vary from four to ten minutes. CD/DVD can be returned, if requested.

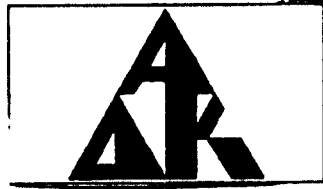
