### **Graduation Practice – Thursday, May 22**

- *Mandatory for all seniors participating in graduation.*
- Doors open at 8:15 AM. Practice begins promptly at 8:30 AM.
- Students should park in the student lot and enter through the front lobby.
- A senior class breakfast will be served before practice begins.
- Tickets for the graduation ceremony will be distributed at the end of practice.
- If your senior does not drive, they will call you when practice concludes.

### **Senior Sunset – Thursday, May 22 | 6:00–8:00 PM**

- Location: Student Parking Lot
- Join us for one last celebration as the sun sets on your senior's high school journey!

### **Graduation Day – Friday, May 23**

- *Students should arrive by 4:00 PM.*
- Stadium gates open at 4:30 PM.
- Graduation begins promptly at 6:00 PM.

### **Important Stadium Guidelines:**

To ensure a smooth and respectful ceremony, the following items are **prohibited**:

- Purses or bags
- Posters or signs
- Open containers, food, or beverages
- Tobacco, alcohol, or weapons
- Noise makers or balloons

### **Seating & Accessibility:**

- Guests may sit in either the home or visitor bleachers.
- Stadium seats are welcome, but please be mindful not to block others' views.
- Reserved handicap seating is available through the pass gate.
- Please carpool when possible and plan to arrive early to avoid delays.

### **After the Ceremony:**

Parents should plan to meet their senior **outside the building** at a designated location of your choosing. Seniors will exit the building after receiving their official documentation.
