addition, these positive daily interactions help to increase more academic success for the students that she is working with. We here at Webb Street School would like to thank you for all that you do.

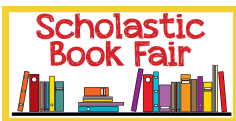
Polar Plunge for Special Olympics
