The goal of North Carolina College Application Week is to provide every graduating high school senior the opportunity to apply to college online through CFNC.org. During this statewide college access event, all North Carolina colleges and universities accept the College Board or ACT fee waiver in lieu of an application fee, for students who qualify. Typically students who receive the SAT or ACT fee waiver, also qualify for the College Board fee waiver. See your high school counselor for more information about the College Board fee waiver. Additionally, many of North Carolina's colleges and universities go above and beyond and outright waive their application fee for all North Carolina graduating seniors that week.
