-North Carolina Virtual Public School (NCVPS): North Carolina Virtual Public School (NCVPS) is the online course for public schools in North Carolina and is governed through the NCVPS organization and the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction. NCVPS courses are available during the regular school day and beyond the regular day. All entrance requirements, grading practices, course content, and course assignments are governed through NCVPS. Honors and AP courses are offered.
