Cyber Security

The Cybersecurity Pathway at EGHS provides knowledge and coursework for entry-level employment supporting network infrastructure environments in various work sectors, including healthcare. The coursework in the Cybersecurity Pathway at EGHS consists of the first year of courses within the Gaston College Networking and Cyber Defense degree program. Upon completion of the Cybersecurity Pathway at EGHS, students can complete the remainder of the degree program in Networking and Cyber Defense at Gaston College.

The National Security Agency (NSA) has designated Gaston College a National Center of Academic Excellence in Cyber Defense (CAE-CD). Institutions receiving this designation have met rigorous requirements established by the NSA and have a commitment to "producing cybersecurity professionals that will reduce vulnerabilities in our national infrastructure," as per the Centers of Academic Excellence in Cybersecurity.

Course work in the Cybersecurity Pathway at EGHS and the Networking and Cyber Defense degree program at Gaston College includes design, installation, configuration, and management of network infrastructure technologies, network operating systems, information policy, and industry best practices to protect data communications. Graduates of the degree program may find employment in entry-level jobs as local area network managers, network operators, network analysts, network technicians and security administrators.
