#### **Attendance Matters**

- No more than 10 absences in each class

## Grades: Major vs. Minor

- At least 3 MAJOR grades each 9-weeks (tests/projects)
- Not doing 1 MAJOR grade will drop your class average 2 letter grades!
   So, give your best effort on these!!!
- Students have 3 days after an absence to request to make up assignments!!!
- Check canvas to verify assignments have been submitted.



#### **Exams**

- Count for 20% of your final grade
- Exempt from exam if your F1 is an A with no more than 4 absences, or a B with no more than 3 absences (excused or unexcused)
- Cannot exempt State Exams:
   English 10, Biology , Math 1, Math 3 and CTE's
- 3 tardies equals 1 absence for exam exemption policy
