How to become a bus driver:

1. Complete an online application

- Please note: In Applitrack, three complete professional references are required.
- 2. Once your application and references are complete, contact our transportation department at (704) 866-6223 to sign up for the NC School Bus & Traffic Safety. This class includes three (3) days of classroom instruction and three (3) days of driving instruction.
- 3. Upon passing tests in bus class on the third day, prospective bus drivers will be given a Background Screen and Drug Test.
- 4. After passing the applicable tests, obtain a commercial driver's license (CDL) with "P" and "S" endorsements.
- 5. School Bus Certification Pocket Card is issued once you have successfully completed the steps listed above.
- 6. Positions may be offered upon successful interview, with employment contingent upon successful background check, drug screen, and reference checks.

Qualifications:

- Must be able to pass the <u>NC school bus driver</u> written and road test
- Must have a valid drivers license for at least six (6) months
- Pass a physical examination as required by State Law
- Must be 18 years of age
- Good driving record
- Must be able to perform the essential functions of the job

The DMV requires all bus driver applicants to obtain a Commercial Learner's Permit (CLP) before scheduling behind the wheel training. The DMV requires you to have your CLP for 14 days before road training.
