TITLE 1 OVERVIEW

- Title I is a federally funded program.
- It provides funding for high poverty schools to help students who are behind academically or at risk of falling behind to meet our state's standards.

 Schools qualify for Title I funds based on the school's percentage of free/reduced priced lunch recipients.

Parent Involvement

The law states that parents in Title I schools have the right to:

- be a part of developing the school parent involvement policy.
- be involved in the planning and implementation of the parent involvement program in their school.
- receive materials and training to foster greater parent involvement.

Parent Involvement

The law states that parents in Title I schools have the right to:

- jointly develop, with school staff, a schoolparent compact.
- know the qualifications of their child's teacher and paraprofessional
 - If a child is being taught by someone who is not "highly qualified" and will be in that position for 4 or more weeks parents will be notified.
