- Additional services, programs, and activities, such as: youth development activities; counseling programs; arts, music, physical fitness and wellness programs; technology education programs; financial literacy programs; environmental literacy programs; and other ties to an in-demand industry sector that are designed to reinforce and complement the regular academic program of participating students; and
- Opportunities to families of students served by 21st CCLCs for active and meaningful engagement in their children's education, including opportunities for literacy and related education development.
