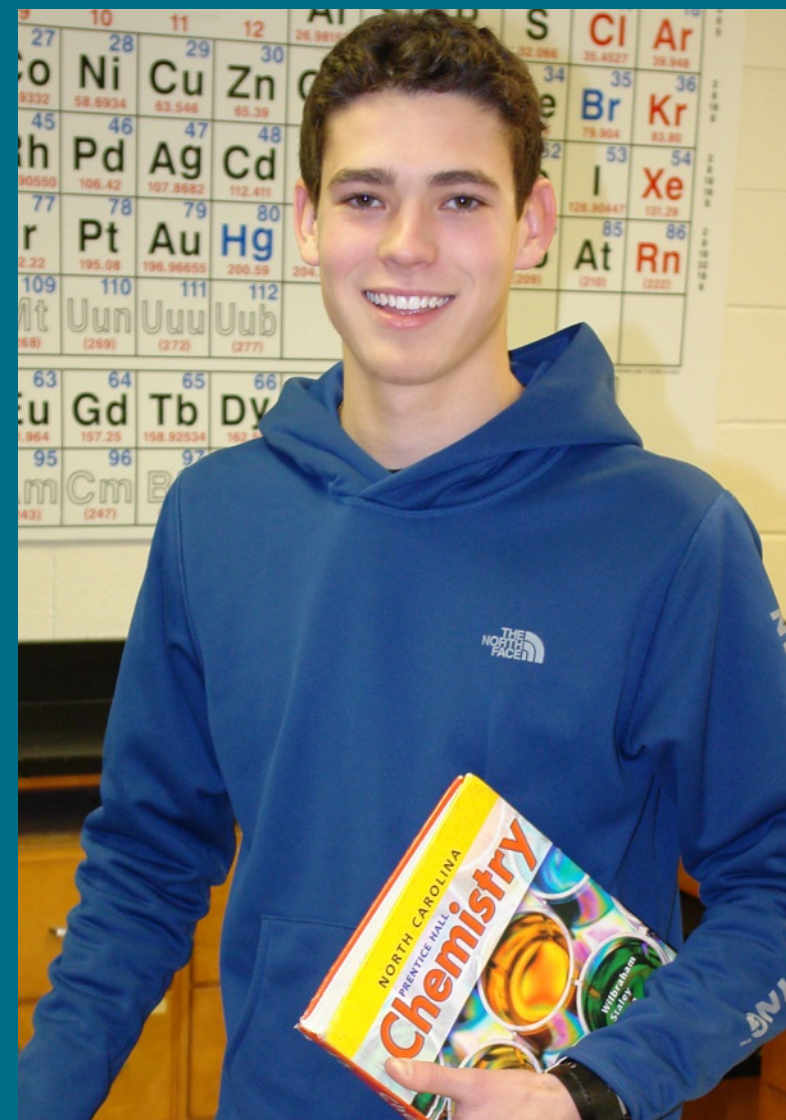

The Early College attracts the best and brightest along with those students who have the potential to be our future leaders.

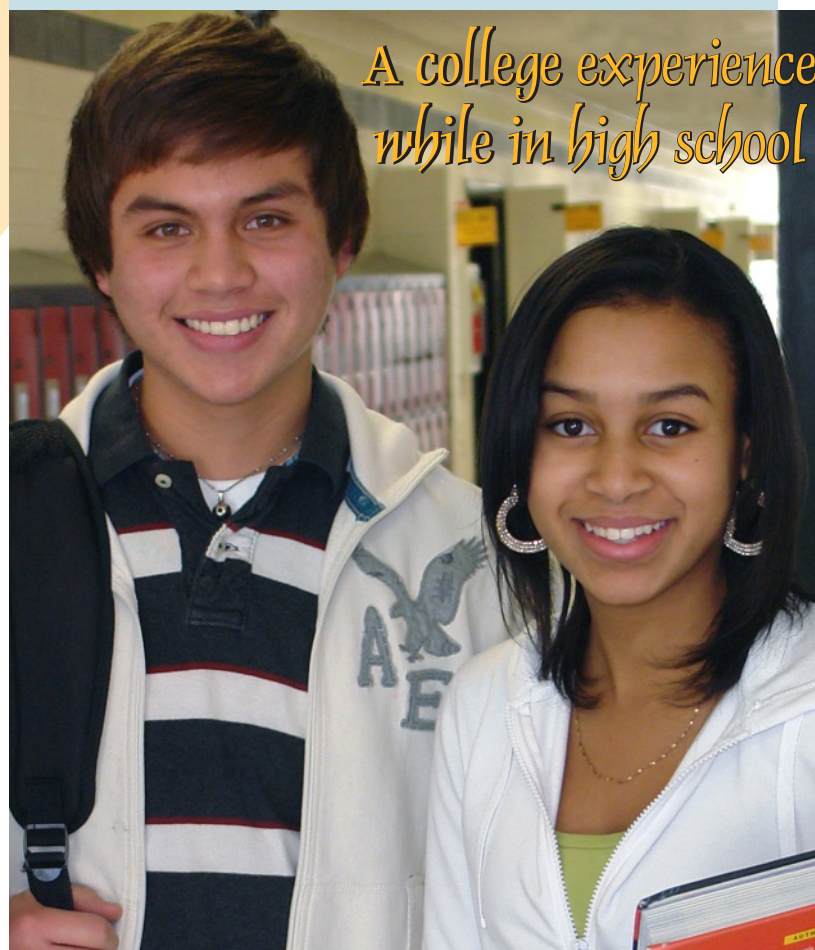
Goals
