

# Mount Holly Middle School Chromebook 1:1 Agreement

The mission of the Mount Holly Middle School remote learning initiative is to ensure that MHMS students have consistent and equitable access to the digital tools and resources that will allow them to be effective and responsible digital-age citizens. This device will be the same one that they will take home with them. This Chromebook may be at home to expand their learning opportunities beyond the walls of MHMS as well as to create and design evidence of their individual learning.

**Costs:**

- There is no cost to receive the device.
- Students are responsible for the cost of a lost or missing Chromebook, charger, or case, and for damage beyond normal use. Repairs will be on a case by case basis and could range up to full replacement of the item. **(Please see MHMS Technology Insurance Letter for full cost of fees)**
- Lost, stolen or questionable damage will be reviewed by the administration on a case-by-case basis to determine fees.

**Be Responsible:**

- No stickers or writing allowed on the device or accessories which might accompany the Chromebook unless given permission.
- Follow all procedures when transporting the device.
- Students must take measures to protect the device from damage or theft.
- At no time shall the device be used for unlawful or inappropriate activities.
- Students are not allowed to let others use or be in possession of their assigned device.

**Be Respectful:**

- Students must follow the Gaston County Schools Acceptable Use Policy at all times while using district-issued devices.
- Violators of the Acceptable Use Policy or items stated in this document will be addressed by the school administration to determine the proper course of action.
- When logging in with a GCS account and/or using a GCS device, students will be filtered according to CIPA and COPPA regulations. Additionally, records and activity may be monitored and are subject to investigation by authorized district personnel.

## 2022/23 MHMS Technology Insurance Parent Acknowledgement

Students are supplied with a chromebook each year for their 1:1 use in the classroom and at home. They do not share these with other students and are solely responsible for the device throughout the year. We understand that accidents happen and for that we offer technology insurance. The insurance fee for the 2022-2023 school year is \$10, non-refundable and covers **one (1)** accident/incident related to the device. **Lost or stolen devices and chargers are not covered under the insurance fee and will be billed at full replacement value. Purposeful damage will also not be covered.** Technology insurance fee must be paid no later than **08/26/22**.

**Chromebook damage (without technology insurance fee PAID) will result in the parent/guardian having to pay the full amount for repair (see below for pricing).**

Please sign below acknowledging that you have read and understand the insurance agreement. This form must be completed and returned with the student along with their signed 1:1 Usage Agreement in order for your student to receive their chromebook.

### 2022-2023 Chromebook Damage Fees

**Repair and/or Replacement Costs**

Loss, theft, or damage of a device must be reported to a teacher or administrator for repair as soon as possible. Students may be responsible for reimbursing the district for the cost of repair or replacement in the event of damage or negligence.

The prices below are the cost estimates for replacement parts as of August 4, 2022. Prices are subject to change based on available pricing at the time of the repair. Prices listed below are pre-tax estimates.

Other repairs will be billed at the cost of replacement parts and will not be marked up. Labor costs will not be added to the cost of any repair. Repair costs will not exceed the value of the Chromebook.
