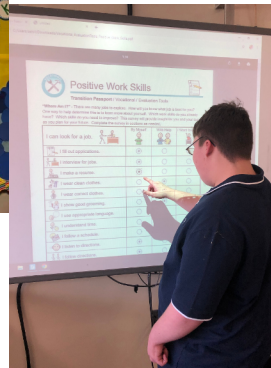
### Intelligent Lives Film
