Aquaponics System going in!

It's hard to believe but the long road of rehabilitating the greenhouses is over and a full aquaponics system is almost up and running. 100 Gardens has been working tirelessly at installing our 4 large fish tank system that will be able to grow close to 700 plants at one time. The Students at Webb have started propagating the first Salanova lettuce seeds that will go in to the system once instillation is complete. A grand opening of the system will be announced soon, all made possible by the Carrie E. and Lena V. Glenn Foundation.
