MISSION

OVERVIEW

Forestview is a four-year public school enrolling more than 1,100 students in grades 9-12.

Forestview High School is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. FHS is proud to house the College Preparatory School Choice Program in our district. Upon successful completion, students in this program may earn the AP Capstone Certificate and Diploma credentials when graduating.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students will need to meet the following requirements to graduate from Gaston County Schools:

- 4 English Credits
- 4 Math Credits
- 3 Science Credits
- 4 Social Studies Credits
- 1 Health/PE Credit
- 12 Elective Credits
 - Including a 4 credit concentration
 - Including 2 World Language if student is college-bound

A total of 28 credits is required to graduate.

Students must also show proficiency on the Math 1, Biology, and English 10 NC End-of-Course exams.

ACADEMIC CURRICULUM

The academic curriculum is organized on a 4x4 block semester system. Students take four 90-minute courses each semester for a total of eight classes per year. Within the curriculum, students are able to take courses on a regular, honors, and Advanced Placement (AP) level. Honors courses are available in all core subject areas and almost all elective areas. Currently, Forestview offers more than 20 Advanced Placement courses on campus. Students that take two or more Advanced Placement courses per year are required to complete an AP project. Our students also have dual enrollment opportunities their junior and senior years and can complete college courses in the NC College and Career Promise / College Now! Initiative.

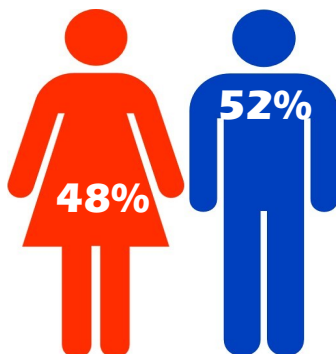

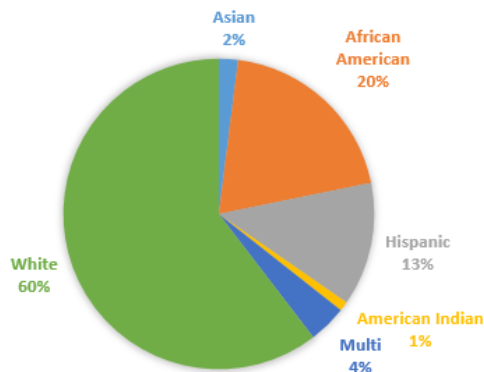

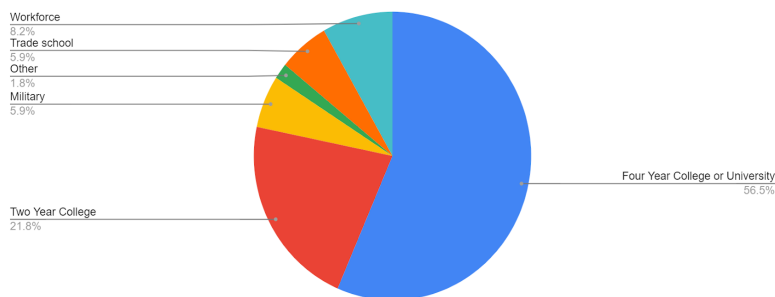
ETHNICITY
