### 1. What is the purpose of the Gifted and Talented Academy at Cramerton?

Students must be in good standing including appropriate attendance, behavior, and academics. Parent/legal guardian must be residents of Gaston County.

#### 3. Who can apply to the Collegiate Preparatory Academy and how are students selected?

Incoming sixth grade students may apply. Student must be identified Academically and Intellectually Gifted (AIG).

#### 4. What are the requirements for continued enrollment?

Parent/legal guardian must maintain residency in Gaston County. Students must be in good standing including appropriate attendance, behavior, and academics. Students must continue to meet AIG requirements.

#### 5. How will my student benefit from the Gifted and Talented Academy at Cramerton Middle?

Cramerton Middle School utilizes the Schoolwide Enrichment Model (SEM) to offer a broad range of advanced level enrichment experiences. This model supports the gifts and talents of our entire student population based on their unique interests.
