Parents/guardians are required to review the information below and agree that if any of the answers to questions 1-3 are "yes," the student will not use school bus transportation services.

1. **Has your child had close contact (within six feet for at least 15 minutes) in the last 14 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, or has any health department or healthcare provider been in contact with you and advised you to quarantine?**

Yes > Your child should NOT be at school. Your child can return 14 days after the last time he or she had close contact with someone with COVID-19 or as listed below.

No > Your child CAN be at school if your child is not experiencing symptoms.

2. **Does your child have ANY of the following symptoms?** Yes (check symptoms below) No

If a student has any of these symptoms, the student should stay home, stay away from other people, and you should contact your healthcare provider.

3. **Since they were last in school, has your child been diagnosed with COVID-19?**

If a student is diagnosed with COVID-19 based on a test, symptoms, or does not get a COVID-19 test but had symptoms, the student should NOT be at school and should stay home until meeting the criteria below.

Your child CAN return to school when a parent/guardian can answer YES to all three questions below.

- Has it been at least 10 days since your child first had symptoms? Yes No
- Has it been at least three days since your child had a fever (without using fever-reducing medicine)?

- Has it been at least three days since your child's symptoms have improved, including cough and shortness of breath?

If your child has had a negative COVID-19 test, the child can return to school and use transportation once there is no fever without the use of fever-reducing medicines and the child has felt well for 24 hours.

If your child has been diagnosed with COVID-19 but does not have any symptoms, the child should remain out of school until 10 days have passed since the date of their first positive COVID-19 diagnostic test, assuming the child has not subsequently developed symptoms since the positive COVID-19 test.

If your child has been determined to have been in close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, the child should remain out of school for 14 days since the last known date of contact unless the child tests positive. In which case, criteria above would apply. The child must complete the full 14-day quarantine even if the child tests negative.
