

### **State Budget Update**

- A comprehensive State budget has not yet been approved
- Senate Bill 332 An Act to Make Changes to the Current Operations Appropriations Act of 2023 became law on July 8, 2024
- This bill authorized intended State salary increases effective July 1, 2024

- Not subject to Retirement

### Salary Increases

- Assistant Principals Remain at 19% of "A"
   Teacher Salary Schedule increase would be
   1.5% 5.1% plus the experience step
- Bus Drivers: 3%
- Classified (hourly) employees: 3%
- Central Office employees: 3%



#### Other Items

- Retirement contribution rate decreased by 3.9% to 24.04%
- Health insurance premiums increased by 7.1% to \$8,095 per year
- Out-of-State teacher license reciprocity for teachers with 3 years experience
- DPI funding in arrears beginning this year



#### Other Items

- EC funding cap of 13% (no change)
- Directs DPI to develop a weighted funding model for future EC services
- Reduced At Risk allotment by \$7 million and replaced by a grant program
- AIG funding cap of 4% (no change)
