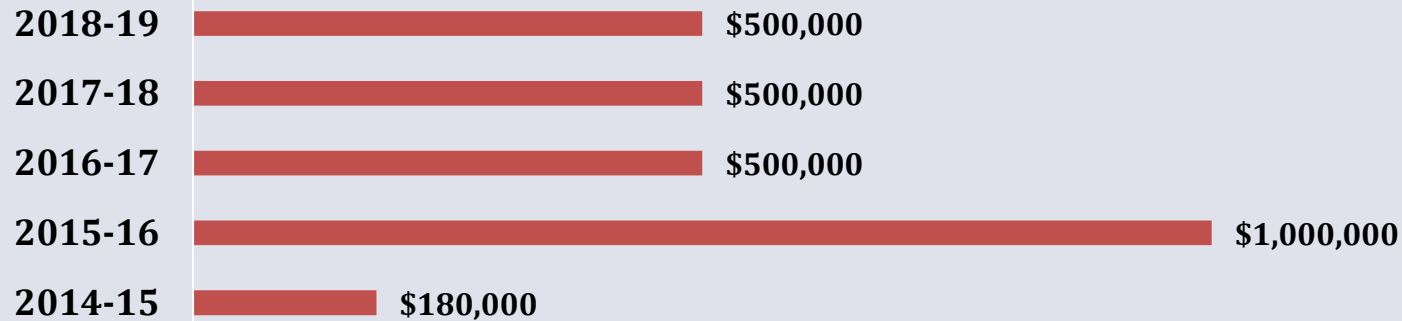

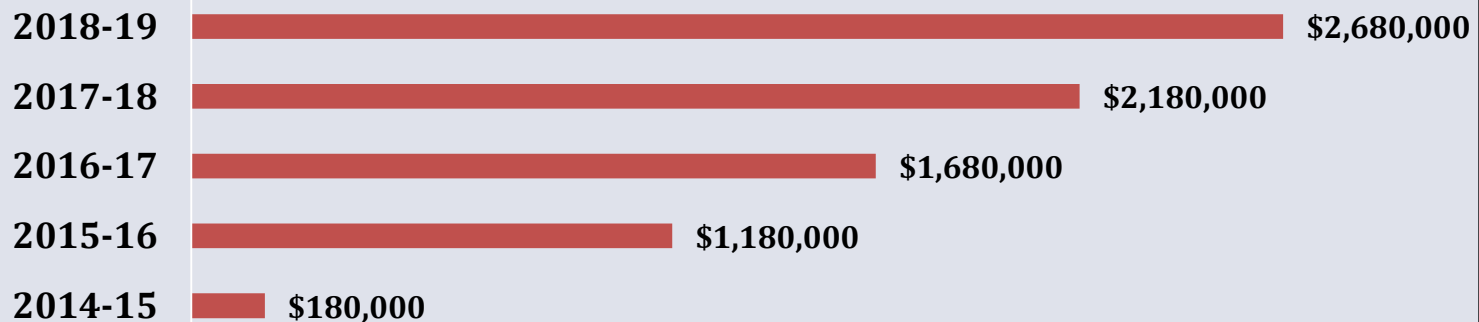

District Increases

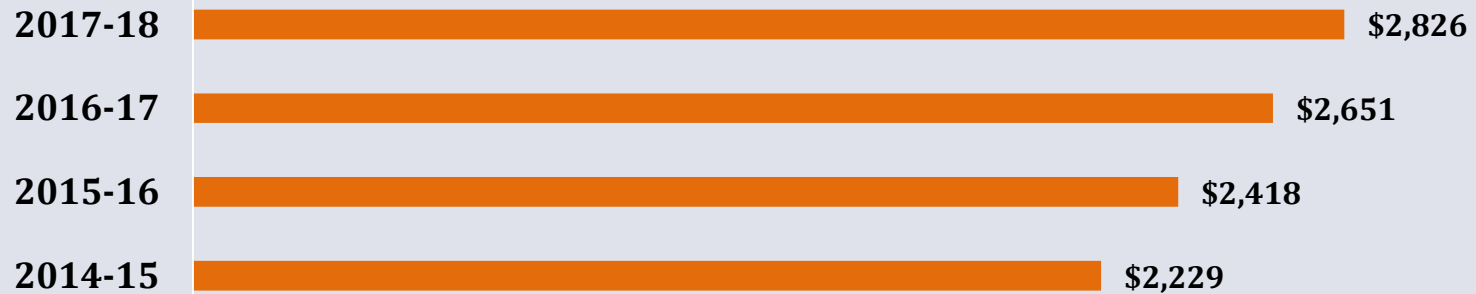


Cumulative District Increases

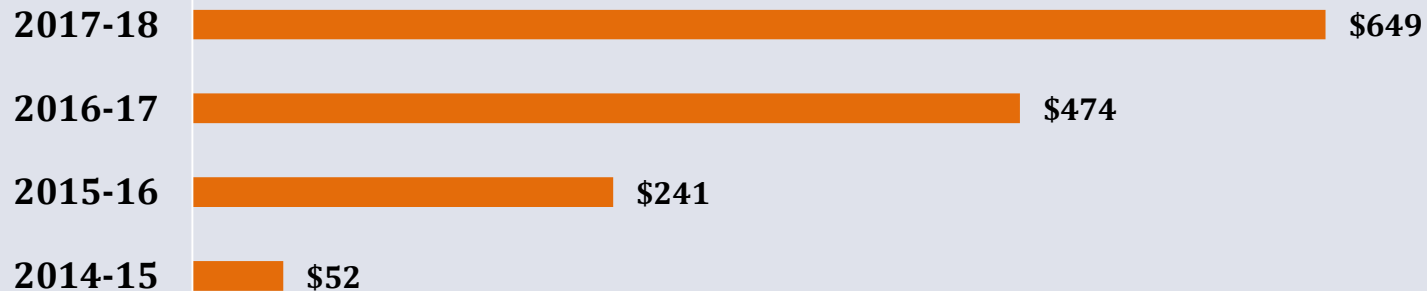

Following approval of the school bond referendum, the Board of Education and the Gaston County Commissioners conducted a meeting to discuss the 2018-2019 local budget for Gaston County Schools, the 2018 school bonds, and the one-quarter of a cent sales tax. As part of the 2018-2019 county budget, the Gaston County Commission approved the issuance of \$60 million in school bonds. The issuance is expected in fall 2018.
