

Forestview AP Inquiry Project Parent/Student Form

I have read the Forestview AP Inquiry Project document (that includes the calendar, rubric, and FAQ's) and have discussed with my child the following:

1. Barring extenuating circumstances, failure to present at the assigned time/day may result in a final grade of zero for their project. This will carry through to all aspects of the project grade.
2. The project will count as their final exam grade in all AP courses taken during the semester in which the inquiry project is assigned. (the exam grade is 1/7 of the overall course grade)
3. Technical problems that are not associated with Forestview electronic infrastructure but are discovered at the time of the presentation will negatively affect the grade (Projects should be tested at school prior to the turn-in date).
4. Annotated bibliographies that are not in formal MLA style or contain fewer than 10 sources among various formats (websites, books, articles) will be penalized according to the rubric specified penalty.
5. Although they must be documented, pictures and videos are not counted as a source unless information pertinent to the presentation is gleaned from them.
6. This form must be completed and turned in along with the Essential Inquiry Question Form and a 9" x 12" (or larger) Manila Envelope with student's name and grade level clearly printed on the outside. The due date is specified in the calendar. Not submitting all three pieces (signed parent form, signed essential inquiry question form, and manila envelope) by the calendar date/time will result in a 10 point penalty.
7. On due dates given in the calendar, materials must be turned in by 8:00 am. If a student knows they will miss due to an appointment, the material needs to be turned in the day before. A tardy or unexcused absence does not justify late materials.
8. All required and accessory documents for the project can be downloaded and copied from the Forestview School website
9. All Gaston County Schools and Forestview High School policies and rules apply. This includes Honor Code, plagiarism, complicity, and cheating.
