
How to Send SAT Scores How to Send Junior year ACT Scores

Please contact the SAT or ACT organizations directly if you have any trouble.

- It is recommended that you have your original (non plagiarized) essays reviewed for grammatical errors before submitting them with your application. It's highly suggested that you save your essays and modify them later for different applications.
- Always keep your passwords and login information in a reliable place because you will access them again, not having this information causes unnecessary delays.

REMINDERS: Proofread your entire application, use black ink when completing documents OR TYPE THEM, use N/A instead of leaving questions blank (this means non applicable), KEEP COPIES of everything, meet "*Postmarked*" deadlines when applicable (the date an item arrives and is stamped by the U.S. Postal Service).

In the event that you have technology barriers, please work with your school counselor in order to work around your issues.

	Take/Retake the SAT or ACT as soon as possible- October! Take at least twice - for SUPER SCORING (ask your counselor for details).		
	Create a document that lists your activities and send a copy to your counselor and others who you will choose to write your recommendations. Give ample time for completion such as 2 weeks for a written letter or 1 week for a form.		
	<u>Brag Sheet Template</u> Apply Early! Many Colleges have application deadlines of mid October and November 1 st for early notification. Some schools require you to complete the application by the early deadline to be eligible for scholarships.		
	Request recommendations from those who know you best (teachers, counselors, community figures)		
	Check each college's website for admissions and scholarship/financial aid information. Send your transcript electronically through www.cfnc.org for NC Colleges or through https://gastonnc.scriborder.com/ out-of-state. *mailing is a "thing of the past.		
	Remember that applying for colleges and applying for scholarships are sometimes separate processes (although in some cases scholarships are offered based on your received application to a college). This is where the newsletter becomes beneficial!		
	Get prior approval before any Off Campus College visit.		
	Create a FASTWEB account at <u>www.fastweb.com</u> . This is a FREE Scholarship search with over
